IT'S TIME TO CLOSE THE DIGITAL DIVIDE IN NORTH CAROLINA

More than a million North Carolina households lack access to high-speed internet, cannot afford it or do not have the skills needed to take advantage of the digital economy. Gov. Roy Cooper has prioritized closing the digital divide to achieve digital equity for all North Carolinians.

Digital Equity Grant Programs

- Office of Digital Equity and Literacy has received \$50 million in American Rescue Plan Act funds over four years
- **We have awarded \$44 million so far:**
 - \$10 million to support 8 state government entities
 - \$4 million to support 3 major anchor institutions
 - \$30 million to support 63 community service, nonprofit, higher education and regional organizations

Digital Champion Grant Program

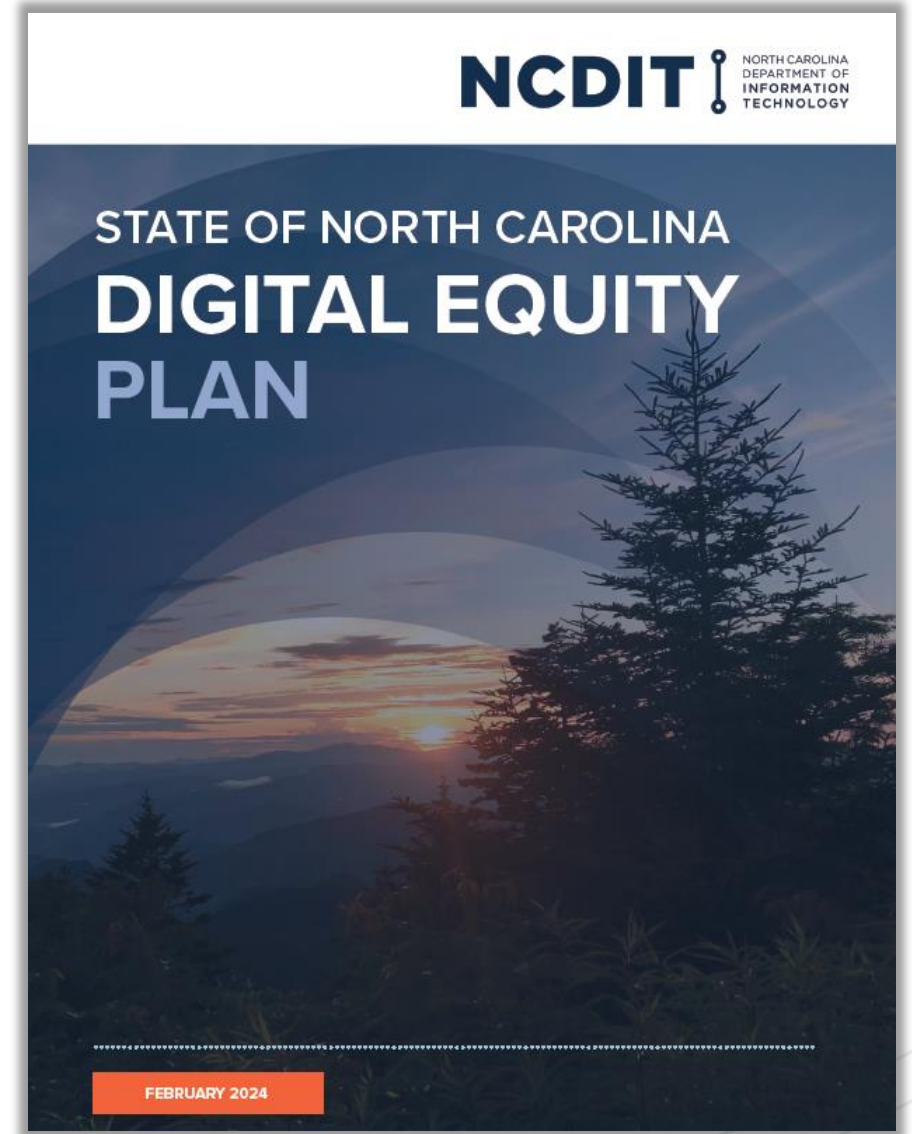
- Awarded \$30 million to 63 organizations in June
- Awardees and project descriptions at ncbroadband.gov/digital-champion-grantees
- Creates partnerships with organizations statewide to implement digital inclusion solutions that positively impact target populations identified in the Digital Equity Act; Received 230 applications from local government, nonprofit, higher education and regional organizations requesting more than \$150 million in funding
- Applications proposed digital equity projects from eligible entities to serve all 100 counties; many counties had project proposals from multiple applicants

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What's Next?

Digital Equity Capacity Grant NOFO released by NTIA

- \$22 million for North Carolina (*only NCDIT could apply*)
- Expected award date: Fall 2024
- Additional funding rounds expected in 2025 and 2026 (so, program may continue until 2031)

- Meets quarterly to discuss state initiatives, share best practices and successes and create partnership opportunities



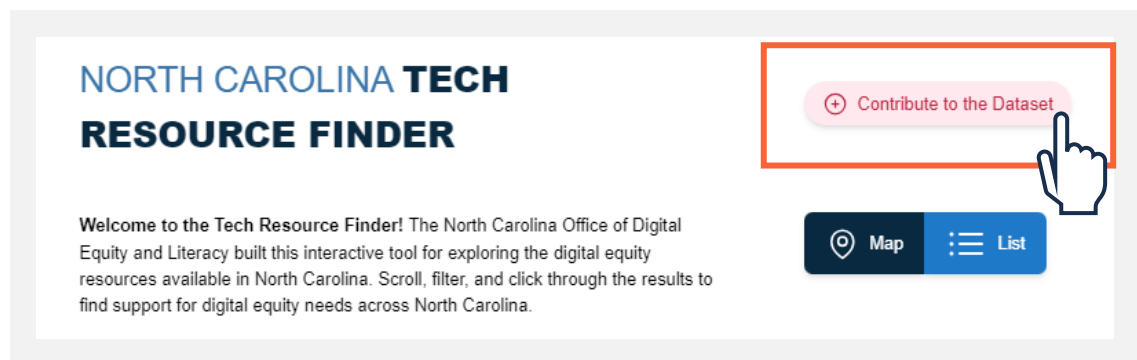
Tech Resource Finder - Site is a Living Tool Powered by Crowdsourced Data

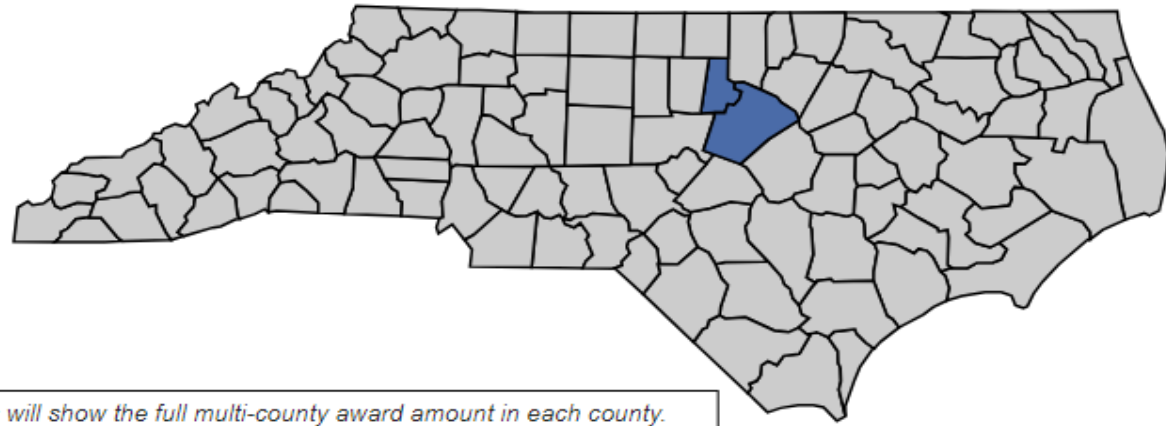
