


The purpose of the hearing was to accept public comment regarding the proposed amendment of the ASLB Rules regarding the definition of an employee set forth in 14B NCAC 17 .0103. (The proposed amendment to 14B NCAC 17 .0103 is attached).

Mr. Kenneth Henke of SECUR TEK, Inc. stated that his main concern is that the rewrite allows mass market companies to solicit sales without registering employees. He stated we need to protect the public. He has been in the alarm industry for several years and his customers expect their information to be protected. He provides quality services and believes this language will allow a "loophole" of a person being registered. He liked the statute before the rewrite- anyone doing alarm business needed to be registered.
