



## WHAT IS THE NC JOBS EXPLORATION IN TRANSITION (NCJET) SYSTEM?

- Objective: To support reentry readiness and improve employment outcomes for incarcerated individuals by connecting them with the NCWorks system.
- System: NCJET is a secure, online system where individuals can:
  - Create a resume
  - Explore careers and related occupations
  - Search for jobs
  - Explore labor market data
  - Apply to jobs & communicate with employers
  - Access to NCWorks Online upon release





## WHY IS NCJET IMPORTANT TO NCDAC?

- Enhances Reentry Success: provides tools for securing employment before release & connects individuals with employers aligned with Reentry 2030
- Supports Rehabilitation Goals: offers structured opportunities for skill development & job search readiness
- Promotes Public Safety: Increased post-release employment reduces reoffending and recidivism
- Connection to NCWorks System: provides system integrated with NCWorks system to facilitate post-release employment services
- Empowers Individuals: self-assessment tools for identifying skills and career paths & ability to search for jobs






## HOW NCJET ADVANCES NCCE WFD FUTURE STATE

## NCCE WFD Future State Vision

- Seamless employment pipeline that starts Day 1 at NCCE plant.
- Grounded in a 2025 evidence assessment of reentry, job training, and apprenticeship programs at NCCE.
- Emphasizes alignment with national best practices for employment-focused reentry programs.






## **DEVELOPMENT & SECURITY OF NCJET**

- NCJET shares a database with the NCWorks Online statewide system & operates off secure desktop connections in facilities and plants
- Users are not able to access internet-based websites, email, or direct messaging systems outside of NCJET











- Related Occupations:
  - Career ladders: Visual representation of career progression opportunities
  - Career informer: Provides detailed information about various careers
  - Job market explorer: Offers insights into job market trends and opportunities
  - Occupational Information
     Network (O\*NET) codes:
     Standardized codes for occupations
     to facilitate job matching





- Labor Market Information:
  - Hot Job locations: Identifies high-demand job locations
  - Information about competition: Provides data on job market competition
  - Job requirements: Details the qualifications needed for specific jobs
  - Salary expectations: Offers information on expected salaries for various jobs
  - Employers open to hiring justice-involved individuals: Lists employers willing to hire formerly incarcerated individuals


#### Job Search & Applying to Jobs:



## PERSPECTIVE FROM INCARCERATED USER AT NCCIW

"This is a huge resource and it's going to be pivotal. It will be ideal for me to get back into the workforce. Any incentive for offenders gives us hope. With hope it helps you to behave and act accordingly. But it also comes with anxiety. What am I going to do?

I don't have an option of running home to someone who will support me. I will leave here with no money except what I've been able to save. Having the ability to start this job search is imperative. It's given me a jump start. I've also been given an opportunity here at the Tag Plant to get my forklift license. The staff here have given us added skills to go out in the real world."
