Overview

Transitional Housing is community based housing provided to adult offenders who are in need of a structured, positive, and safe environment for a period of up to 90 days. The length of stay in Transitional Housing will be based on needs for a minimum of 90 days up to a maximum of 120 days.



Facility and Program Requirements

DAC Transitional Housing will provide community-based services that will address the needs of returning citizens to ensure successful reentry.

Transitional Housing offers some, but not limited to the below support services.

- HRD, Job Development
- Life Skills
- Job Readiness Training
- Job Search Assistance
- Vocational Training
- Transportation
- Assistance Obtaining Identification
- Assistance with Medical Needs
- TH can assist residents to develop a permanent housing plan.
- Residents will have access to participate in all components of DAC Transitional Housing.

All Transitional Housing requests must be initiated by the Case Manager or PPO by submitting the DCS-140 to Rehabilitation and Reentry at DCC_ProgramServices@dac.nc.gov

Requirements

- Participation must be voluntary
- Offender must be 18 years or older
- Offender must be homeless or have no home plan
- Under probation, parole, or post-release supervision for at least 90 days
- Offender must not have any severe mental health or medical conditions
- No current or prior arson or burning convictions
- Does not have family or community resources willing to assist with living arrangements
- Must be able to seek gainful employment
- Will cooperate with all rules of the TH, expected programs, and its partner agencies
