DAC Transitional Housing

Transitional Housing is community based housing provided to adult offenders who are in need of a structured, positive, and safe environment for a period of up to 90 days. The length of stay in Transitional Housing will be based on needs for a minimum of 90 days up to a maximum of 120 days.

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Requirements

1. Participation must be voluntary.
2. Offender must be 18 years or older.
3. Must be homeless, have unstable housing, or have no home plan upon release.
4. Under probation, parole, or post-release supervision for at least 90 days.
5. Must not have severe mental health or medical conditions.
6. Must not have current or prior arson or burning convictions.
7. Must not have family or community resources willing to assist with living arrangements.
8. Must be able to seek gainful employment.
9. Will cooperate with all rules of the Transitional home, expected programs, and its partner agencies.



Facility and Program Requirements

DAC Transitional Housing will provide community based services that will address the needs of returning citizens, including but not limited to the below support services:

1. HRD, Job Development
2. Life Skills
3. Job Readiness Training
4. Job Search Assistance
5. Vocational Training
6. Transportation
7. Assistance Obtaining Identification
8. Assistance with Medical Needs
9. Assistance developing a permanent home plan
